This award will be presented to the contestant judged as the most photogenic based on the following criteria: visual appeal, expressiveness, and composition by the judges.

Best wear

This award is presented to the contestant who has the highest votes from the judges during the group exit from the introduction round.

Most Talented

This award is presented to the contestant with the highest talent round scores.

Best Self-designed

This award is presented to the contestant with the highest self-design round scores.





RULES & REGULATIONS

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age by November 24, 2023 (ID required)
- Must be no older than the age of 30 (ID required)
- Female only (ID required)
- Single with no prior marriage or no dependent(s)
- Have the ability to speak Hmong.
- Must be enrolled/graduated in high school or have successfully completed the G.E.D. testing program for high school equivalency.
- Must be in good health and participate fully and without limitations in program activities.
- · At least one biological parent of Hmong descent
- Must reside in the State of California

REGISTRATION

Non-refundable registration fee of \$250.

SPONSORSHIP

Sponsorship Fee is \$300.00.

Sponsors who paid the sponsorship fee will be announced and recognized during the pageant rounds. Each contestant may have up to 10 sponsors. DEADLINE FOR SPONSORSHIP: November 1, 2023

Contestants are required to attend all rehearsals, training sessions, and publicity events. If there are any conflicts, please inform the pageant chair.

Constant lateness and absences will result in removal from participation round(s).

We reserve the right to terminate your standing as a candidate if there is excessive absence.

Training is every Saturday from 9 AM - 3 PM. If there are any changes to the time and/or day, the pageant committee will inform the contestants. No one other than the contestant will be allowed to attend training. This includes families, friends, pageant coaches, and sponsors.

DROP OUT

If a contestant forfeits/drop out after she has submitted her application, she will be responsible for paying \$200 to Sacramento Hmong New Year, Inc.

MODELING AND SPEECH COACHING

We will provide modeling and speech coaching during the training/rehearsal sessions. We do not discourage you from seeking additional training. However, any training and coaching you seek will be your responsibility.

WARDROBE, COSTUME, AND MAKEUP

Guidelines will be provided. Participants will be responsible for their own wardrobe, costumes, and makeup.

Bubbles, water, fire stunts, and sharp objects are prohibited in any pageant segment.

VALUABLES

It is imperative that all garments, valuables, and any personal property be brought to the pageant in a "Lockable" suitcase marked with your name. SHNY – Pageant organization will not be held responsible for any damage or loss of property that may arise. The designated individual is responsible for ensuring that all valuables and garments are supervised throughout the day.

TATTOOS AND PIERCINGS

Contestants are only permitted to wear one (1) pair of earrings in each ear lobe. Visible tattoos on any part of

the body will NOT be tolerated. These will need to be professionally covered for our Pageant. Excessive piercings will need to be removed for the pageant.
BACKSTAGE ACCESS No family or friends will be allowed in the dressing rooms during the competition. Only makeup artists and hair stylists wearing their designated badges will be given access backstage to support their contestants and will be limited to two (2) per contestant.
TERMINATION We reserve the full right to terminate your candidacy at any time should any of the following occur. Wrongful acts Crime/Felony Fraudulent Adult contents Bribery
Under no circumstances should a contestant have posed or have been photographed, video nude, or semi-nude and appeared in a publication, film, or internet.
BEHAVIOR Contestants MUST abide by the Rules and Regulations herein. They should, at all times, display first-rate manners, etiquette, and team spirit and exercise sportsman-like behavior to all other contestants, finalists, members of staff, and all associated. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will any profanities, racially motivated comments, harassment, obscene or abusive language, or gestures be permitted. This includes parental and guest activity. Please alert your guests of this rule. Any Contestant, family member, or guest found to be displaying such conduct shall be automatically disqualified from the pageant without a refund of Registration Fees.
All contestants are encouraged to use their social networking pages, such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, etc., to promote their entry into the Pageant. As you will be presenting the Miss Hmong CA Pageant Organization, we ask that you pay close attention to the comments, photographs, and messages you are posting and that they are befitting your etiquette as a contestant. Suppose any contestant or Queen is found to have inappropriate photographs, defamatory comments, or vial behavior. In that case, they will be immediately disqualified without reimbursement of the Registration Fee, and their title will be relinquished.
SCORING/SCORE SHEETS Contestants understand that the judges' decisions and scoring are final and will not be changed.
If you want your score sheets after the pageant competition, please request them from the pageant chair. Score sheets are not given out at the end of the pageant event; allow 1-2 weeks before receiving. The names of the Pageant judges will NOT be released on the scoresheet requested by the contestants.
TIEBREAKER In the event of a tie, the Tie-Breaker protocol will engage. Ties are only broken if there is a tie-in for the top 3 finalists. The contestants with equal scores (tie) will be asked an additional question. Contestants will be asked the same question individually on stage. Judges will use the same criteria used on the Question round.
All rules can be changed by the Pageant Director as deemed appropriate.

POLICIES

- 1. SHNY, Inc. reserves the right to cancel the pageant event if participation numbers are less than six (6). In the case of a cancellation, contestants will be fully reimbursed within 30 days. All fees are otherwise non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.
- 2. SHNY, Inc. reserves the right to terminate any contestant due to bad sportsmanship. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES will any profanities, racially motivated comments, harassment, obscene or abusive language, or gestures be permitted. This policy also extends to the family and supporters of contestants.
- 3. SHNY, Inc. reserves the right to accept or reject contestants' applications at any time with no explanation.
- 4. Contestants who violate the terms and conditions of SHNY will be automatically removed from the pageant event.
- 5. Any contestant who has won First Place in another pageant within the same year shall not be accepted.
- 6. Contestants are required to attend all scheduled meetings, rehearsals, and events planned specifically for the contestants. In the case of emergencies, contestants are required to inform the Pageant Chair.
- 7. SHNY, Inc. is not liable for any accidents or injuries sustained during meetings, rehearsals, and/or throughout the New Year event.
- 8. SHNY, Inc. is not responsible for any lost or stolen property during meetings, rehearsals, and/or throughout the New Year event.
- 9. All contestants will give consent and permission for SHNY to televise, record, and video the pageant program.
- 10. Any videos or photographs taken during or after the pageant may be used by SHNY, Inc. for advertising and publicity purposes not limited to brochures, flyers, web advertisements, and other marketing materials.
- 11. Judges' information will not be given out prior to competition dates to prevent contestants from contacting them before the pageant event.
- 12. No refund will be given if the contestant fails to attend the pageant or is disqualified due to misconduct by the contestant or a family member.
- 13. Contestants cannot be an IMMEDIATE family member of the Sacramento Hmong New Year, its Officers, Boards, agents, employees, and/or any persons under its direction or control (collectively "SHNY"). For this section, immediate family members shall be defined as a daughter or sister of the SHNY board members.

Miss Hmong California 2023-2024 Terms and Conditions For all Titleholders (1st and Runners-Up)

- 1. The crowned Miss Hmong California shall not compete in any other Hmong Pageants within the same year. If she competes in other Hmong Pageants within the same year, the 1st runner-up will be her successor.
- 2. All Titleholders (1st and Runners-Up) will give permission for their name to be used in conjunction with any publicity to do with the pageant and also agree to be interviewed by the press and associated media should the situation arise.
- 3. All Titleholders (1st and Runners-Up) grant permission to Sacramento Hmong New Year, Inc. to use their speeches, photos, and videos in pageant-related media for advertising and promotional purposes and understands that such pageant materials will become the property of Sacramento Hmong New Year, Inc. and will not be returned.
- 4. All Titleholders (1st and Runners-Up) acknowledge that your Miss Hmong CA Title is owned and regulated by Sacramento Hmong New Year, Inc.
- 5. Miss Hmong California is required to participate in all events that SHNY requests during her reign, except in emergency situations.
- 6. Miss Hmong California is required to engage in the Hmong Community to present and educate personal platforms, goals, or career objectives at any local community event or booth in the State of California.
- 7. Miss Hmong California is required to return and work with SHNY in planning the following year's New Year Celebration. It is required for Miss Hmong California to assist with training the upcoming contestants.
- 8. Miss Hmong California, the 1st runner-up, and the 2nd runner-up are required to train the contestants and work with the pageant team.
- 9. Miss Hmong California, 1^{st,} and 2nd runners-up are expected to serve as respectable role models and maintain a positive character.
- 10. Without prior consent, all Titleholders (1st and Runners-Up) shall not engage themselves in any activities promoting the title as "Miss Hmong California."
- 11. All Titleholders (1st and Runners-Up) that are engaged in any activities promoting the title "Miss Hmong California" will NOT accept any gifts, such as cash amounts, for personal gain.
- 12. Sponsor(s) may advertise Miss Hmong California with his/her business with a written agreement between Miss Hmong California and the sponsor(s) for any advertisement.
- 13. Miss Hmong California must maintain the same marital status until after her reign.
- 14. If Miss Hmong California cannot fulfill her duties, her title and crown shall be passed onto the 1st runner-up as her successor. If the 1st runner-up cannot fulfill her duties as well, the title and crown shall be presented to the 2nd runner-up.

If I cannot perform the duties above, become married legally or culturally, or become pregnant, I will notify SHNY immediately. My title as Miss Hmong California will be terminated, and I will be responsible for handing over my crown to SHNY. In such a case, the First runner-up will assume the role and title of Miss Hmong California 2024.
